

DMCA Notice Procedure

Effective Date: August 1, 2026

11th Hour Print Solutions complies with the Digital Millennium Copyright Act ("DMCA"), 17 U.S.C. § 512. If you believe that content appearing on our website or submitted through our services infringes your copyright, you may submit a DMCA notice.

Filing a DMCA Notice

Your written notice must include:

1. A physical or electronic signature of the copyright owner or authorized representative.
2. Identification of the copyrighted work claimed to have been infringed.
3. Identification of the allegedly infringing material and sufficient information to locate it.
4. Your contact information, including:
 - Name
 - Address
 - Telephone number
 - Email address
5. A statement that you have a good-faith belief that the use is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law.
6. A statement that the information provided is accurate and, under penalty of perjury, that you are authorized to act on behalf of the copyright owner.

Counter-Notification

If you believe content was removed or disabled in error, you may submit a written counter-notification containing:

1. Your signature.
2. Identification of the removed material.
3. A statement under penalty of perjury that you have a good-faith belief the material was removed due to mistake or misidentification.
4. Your name, address, and telephone number.
5. A statement consenting to the jurisdiction of the federal court in your district, or if outside the United States, any district where the Company may be found.

Repeat Infringer Policy

The Company may suspend or terminate accounts of users who repeatedly violate intellectual property rights.
